

## 2023 CIRCLE CITY FLYERS ELECTION BALLOT FORM



### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- You must be a current Circle City Flyers club member to vote in our 2022 election for the 2023 calendar year.
- Vote for only one candidate per club position (president, vice-president, treasurer, secretary, member-at-large). A valid write-in candidate's name (must be a club member) is permitted. Place a check-mark in the box next to the candidate's name to indicate your vote. Please legibly print all 'Write-In' candidate names.
- All mail-in ballots must be returned and received by **NOVEMBER 17, 2022** or they will not be counted in the final tally at the November club meeting. Club Members may cast their vote in person at the November meeting. The votes will be counted and the results announced in the December newsletter, and at the December club meeting/party.
- A majority vote is required to win the election. Elected officers serve for one year from January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023. Supporting Personnel will be appointed by the elected officers and confirmed by a simple majority vote of those members present and voting during the regular meeting. ### IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR 2022


- FIRE EXTINGUISHERS ARE MANADORY AT THE FIELD. Please bring a fire extinquisher when you fly. <u>Make sure that the extinquisher is charged!</u>
- WEAR YOUR CLUB BADGES AT THE FIELD.
- CLUB MEMBERSHIP DUES, APPLICATION FORM, AMA TRUST AND FAA REGRISTRATION NEEDED. Your 2022 Club Membership Dues must be paid prior to February 1st if you want to maintain your membership in the club and flying privileges. You can give your payment to the Ethan Marsh, Club Secretary, pay on the website, so send a check (not cash) to CIRCLE CITY FLYERS, P.O. BOX 78732, CORONA, CA 92877. Please fill out and submitted your application form with any updated information. Don't forget to include your AMA and FAA Registration Number. Once you pay your membership dues you will receive the new gate lock combination for 2022.
- <u>CLUB MEETINGS</u>. Our club meetings are the 3rd Saturday of the month and held at the field. Meeting time is 11AM and it usually lasts for 1 hour. Most of the time we have a small raffle. ### HELPFUL FIELD AND CLUB HINTS WHILE AT THE FIELD

- Obey all AMA and Club Safety Rules. Wear your badge at the field.
- In case of fire at the field, call 911 immediately. If fire crews appear, either by truck and/or by air, immediately cease flying and ground your aircraft. All emergency responders, fire and law enforcement, are given priority to combat any and all threats that endanger life, property and the safety of individuals. Please do your best to assist and not be part of the problem.



• All members are required to have an ABC Fire Extinguisher at the field when they fly located in the pit area. Fly safe and be safe. Bring a First Aid Kit as added protection.



- Our field is in an area populated by wildlife including snakes. Please be aware of this
  danger and act accordingly when walking in the brush.
- Please pickup your trash before leaving the field and dispose of it in trash containers
  or if needed take it home with you.
- Fly with a buddy! Sometimes having an extra set of hands and eyes are helpful.
