...and we all know it's no fun when someone gets hurt.*

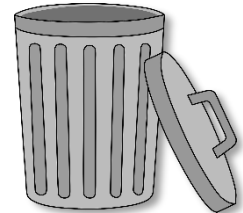
- Obey all AMA and Club Guidelines.
