You can go to the remote ID proposal page on the federal website (https://www.federalregister.gov/docum...) to do that. Click on the "SUBMIT A FORMAL COMMENT" button at the top of the page. The number of negative responses they receive probably matters more than anything. Please take 5 minutes to do this.

- AMA Grant Program. Eric Ische volunteered to look into the AMA grant program for next year to see if they will help us with slurry sealing the runway.

NEW BUSINESS:

- <u>GO-Daddy Contract.</u> President Rick reported the Club website contract with Go-Daddy has expired and is now hosted by Site-Ground at a cost of \$249.95 for 3 years.
- <u>Bank Account Signatures.</u> President Rick announced that the bank accounts signatures have been changed to himself and our new treasurer Don Ralston.
- <u>AMA Charter Renewal.</u> Secretary Ethan Marsh reported that he needed a check for \$120 for AMA Charter Club renewal. \$40 for the Charter and \$80 for Club Insurance for 2020.
- <u>Club Fly-In.</u> A Club Fly-In was brought up by Rick with a suggested date of June 27th. This was discussed with a decision pending further information.
- <u>Night Fly Event</u>. Kory Drasein asked about holding a night fly event at Deleo Field. Erik Ische will check with AMA.
- <u>Members without FAA Registration</u>. Ethan marsh reported there is a list of names posted on the bulletin board at the field with the names of members with no known FAA Registration Number.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR 2020

- FIRE EXTINGUISHERS ARE MANADORY AT THE FIELD. Please bring a fire extinguisher when you fly.
- WEAR YOUR CLUB BADGES AT THE FIELD.
- <u>AMA DUES</u>. Your 2020 AMA DUES need to be renewed ASAP. All members must be current with your AMA Dues in order to fly at the field for insurance purposes.
- <u>CLUB MEMBERSHIP DUES</u>, <u>APPLICATION FORM</u>, <u>AND FAA REGRISTRATION NEEDED</u>. Your 2020 Club Membership Dues must be paid prior to February 1st if you want to maintain your membership in the club and flying privileges. You can give your payment to the Ethan Marsh, Club Secretary, pay on the website, so send a check (not cash) to CIRCLE CITY FLYERS, P.O. BOX 78732, CORONA, CA 92877. Please fill out and submitted your application form with any updated information. Don't for to include your AMA and FAA Registration Number. Once you pay your membership dues you will receive the new gate lock combination for 2020.
- <u>SLURRY FUND</u>. If you haven't paid your Slurry Fund Donation of \$100 then please do so. The Slurry Fund was initiated in 2018 and some members have not contributed to it yet or have not paid the full amount. You can pay on GoFundMe website, or give your check to a club officer, or mail it to CIRCLE CITY FLYERS, P.O. BOX 78732, CORONA, CA 92877. The monies collected will be used to slurry the runway which is estimated to cost between \$6k to \$7k.
- <u>CLUB MEETINGS</u>. Our club meetings are the 3rd Saturday of the month and held at the field. Meeting time is 11AM and it usually lasts for 1 hour. Most of the time we have a small raffle. There is no flying permitted during the club meetings. If you have any issues or concerns then please come to the meeting and express them.

HELPFUL FIELD AND CLUB HINTS WHILE AT THE FIELD

- Obey all AMA and Club Safety Rules.
- In case of fire at the field, call 911 immediately. If fire crews appear, either by truck and/or by air, immediately cease flying and ground your aircraft. All emergency responders, fire and law enforcement, are given priority to combat any and all threats that endanger life, property and the safety of individuals. Please do your best to assist and not be part of the problem.



- All members are required to have an ABC Fire Extinguisher at the field when they
 fly located in the pit area. Fly safe and be safe. Bring a First Aid Kit as added protection.
- Our field is in an area populated by wildlife including snakes. Please be aware of this
 danger and act accordingly when walking in the brush.
- Please pickup your trash before leaving the field and dispose of it in trash containers
 or if needed take it home with you.
- Fly with a buddy! Sometimes having an extra set of hands and eyes are helpful.
