If you are not feeling sharp and alert bad things can happen especially when piloting our planes through the sky. It's a safety risk to your plane, your body and the members around you if you aren't thinking clearly. For example, you make a mistake like forgetting your e-bird is plugged in and you "test" the throttle stick. PROP STRIKE! The safety of all our member is the top priority at CCF. Please remember this when at the field.



At CCF safety is our #1 priority, followed closely by having fun... ...and we all know it's no fun when someone gets hurt.


- Obey all AMA and Club Guidelines.
