

At CCF safety is our #1 priority, followed closely by having fun... ...and we all know it's no fun when someone gets hurt.


- Obey all AMA and Club Guidelines.

Deleo Field

Is home to the Circle City Flyers. Nestled against the foothills just off the 15 freeway in secluded Temescal Canyon featuring a paved 500 x 50 foot runway. Running southeast to northwest our club site also features a 200 foot covered awning as well as waste facilities.
