No April Meeting Was Held Next Club Meeting Saturday May 20th

Hi! I'm your Editor and Webmaster, Erich.

As we have no meeting minutes to report this month I figured I'd utilize the space to reiterate some of our core safety rules as we have seen increasing violations recently and want to "nip it in the bud" before we have any serious issues.

Double Yellow Line / No Fly Zones

The double yellow line is **NEVER** to be crossed.

DO NOT fly over the motor cycle tracks when in use.

DO NOT fly unnecessarily close to any of the power lines.

Fire Extinguishers and Staging

As a follow up reminder, every pilot is **REQUIRED** to have a fire extinguisher staged and ready to be used in an emergency, please don't leave it in your car. If left at home, it should be treated the same as if you forgot batteries or your TX. **Don't Fly.**

Safety Reminders I shouldn't even have to publish again...

No flying under the influence.

No smoking in the pits.

Be courteous of your Prop/Jet Blast.

No "hands off" Taxing into or out of the pits.

Pilots are **Required** to be in pilot stations, behind fences while flying. Communicate anytime someone has to enter the active runway area. (eq. Landed aircraft retrieval or filming)

Relevant Story Time:

We recently had a new visitor drop into the field to check it out. While the atmosphere was inviting and the membership was our usual awesome selves, this individual observed casual violations of more than one of the above items I just mentioned. It was enough that they were prompted to make the comment "This is a chartered club..?"

This is not at all the picture we ever want to paint. I know we pride ourselves on being a much more fun focused and way less political club than most, but it cannot be at the expense of safety or our Charter.

I'm asking us all to DO BETTER!
