Remember that starting with 2020 member renewals, CCF will REQUIRE a copy of your FAA registration card AND an AMA membership to renew CCF club membership next year. Several clubs were already shut down due to violations of the FAA requirement so the board is being proactive with this requirement. In addition, since the year is almost over this subject is of concern, those that have not yet donated your annual \$50 donation to the slurry fund please do so now. Out of the 65 or so members, only about 10 individual members have actually donated to the fund in 2019. That's terrible! This is by far the biggest expense our club endures & we WILL NOT get there on dues alone. We are making progress with the fund, but slow donations means slow progress. If we don't fill the cracks & slurry our runway in the next couple of years our great field will eventually be unflyable. 

#### HELPFUL FIELD AND CLUB HINTS WHILE AT THE FIELD

- Obey all AMA and Club Safety Rules.
- In case of fire at the field, call 911 immediately. If fire crews appear, either by truck and/or by air, immediately cease flying and ground your aircraft. All emergency responders, fire and law enforcement, are given priority to combat any and all threats that endanger life, property and the safety of individuals. Please do your best to assist and not be part of the problem.



- As of January 1, 2019 all members are required to have an ABC Fire Extinguisher
   at the field when they fly located in the pit area. Fly safe and be safe. Bring a First
   Aid Kit as added protection.
- Our field is in an area populated by wildlife including snakes. Please be aware of this danger and act accordingly when walking in the brush.
- Please pickup your trash before leaving the field and dispose of it in trash containers or
  if needed take it home with you.
- Fly with a buddy! Sometimes having an extra set of hands and eyes are helpful!
