It's a safety risk to your plane, your body and the members around you if you aren't thinking clearly. For example, you make a mistake like forgetting your e-bird is plugged in and you "test" the throttle stick. PROP STRIKE! The safety of all our member is the top priority at CCF. Please remember this when at the field.

At CCF safety is our #1 priority, followed closely by having fun... ...and we all know it's no fun when someone gets hurt.


- Obey all AMA and Club Guidelines.

Circle City Flyers is a group of people who love RC flying.

Normal folks, who find the utmost joy in creating and flying wonderful machines that inspire, awe and put just a bit of color in the sky.

CCF is a non-profit, AMA affiliated flying club and we have one of the best flying facilities in Southern California. We are located just south of Corona, California, just a few minutes from the 15 Freeway.

The club is well established (AMA Charter est. 1990) and member's interests encompass the entirety of aviation. We fly gas, electric, glow, & electrics; Scale, 3D, and FPV; Profiles, combat wings, multi-rotors, helicopters and even a couple turbines.

We have RC pilots who have flown for 40+ years, and beginners who are just learning the joys of flight.

Got a question? Just learning? Curious? Come on down!

You can find folks flying most days, with the weekend mornings being the most popular. Mornings are calm with winds generally increasing throughout the day.

<u>How and when did you get started in RC</u> <u>Aviation?</u>

"I started building balsa wood gliders while in 6th grade. Does anyone remember the Wanderer and Windfree by Marks Models? High-Start launches at Loma Vista

Elementary school yard and slope soaring at the local hills was my main focus. My dad (Virgil Sr.) built our first 2ch radio from Heathkit. During the 70's my father ran a machine shop - a portion of that business was focused on 1/8 scale RC race cars.

Almost every weekend I would join my father at the race track testing out his latest ideas. Our favorite track was in the parking lot of Briggs Cunningham automotive museum in Costa Mesa. They allowed the club to paint a permanent course on the lot. Sadly, Briggs sold his automobile collection and closed the museum in 1987. As a kid I met the founder of Associated Electric

when they manufactured gas RC 1/8" scale race cars."

What types of RC Flying do you do?

"Mostly fixed wing. About every 5 years or so I dive into helicopters - crash them - and go back to fixed wing My son Virgil-Jordan learned how to fly Heli's on my Hirobo Shuttle ZX at the CCF field- after that - there was no stopping him ..."

What is your current "Go to"/Favorite RC aircraft?

"I go through phases like many modelers. This year it's been motor-gliders and battle wings. Basically I enjoy them all and really appreciate the breadth of aircraft we have at CCF."

What brings/brought you to CCF?

"Initially it was location...but quickly became the wonderful club members. CCF has a rich and long history of inclusiveness, camaraderie and support. The CCF culture is truly one of a kind. Through the years Virgil-Jordan and I have had numerous "Mentors" including Ethan Marsh, Ed Harkley and Scott Lee just to name a few. "

What else can we find you doing outside of CCF?

"Other hobbies include off-roading (easy trails - nothing too crazy - but there have been times), muscle cars and some of you may have seen my little truck (check out the instagram link below). "
